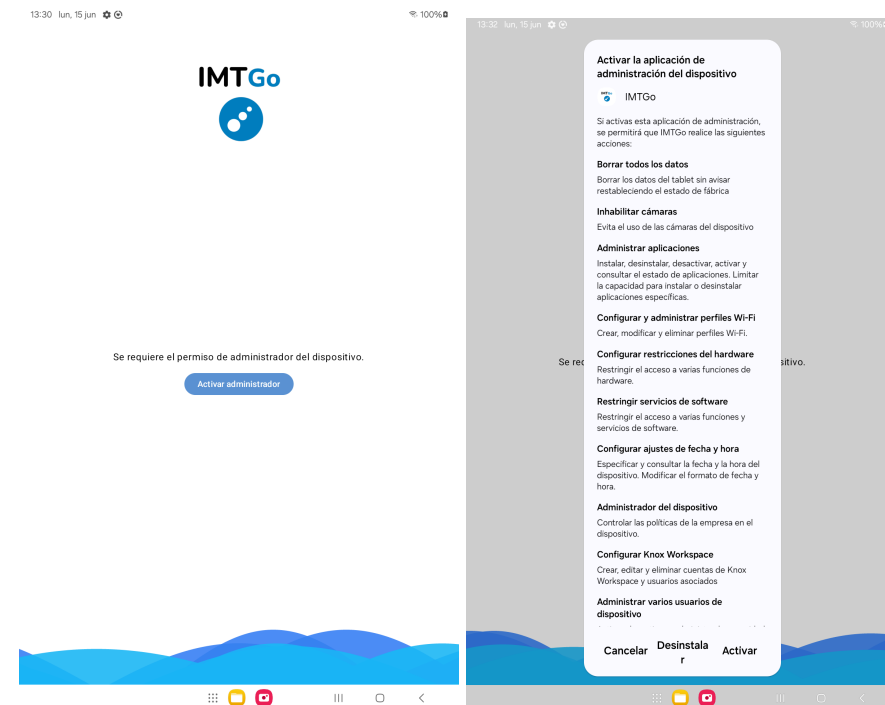
Installing IMTGo on Android

Application Deployment:

After installing the application from the Google Play Store, open IMTGo for the first time to complete the deployment of the agent/browser.

Device Administrator Permission

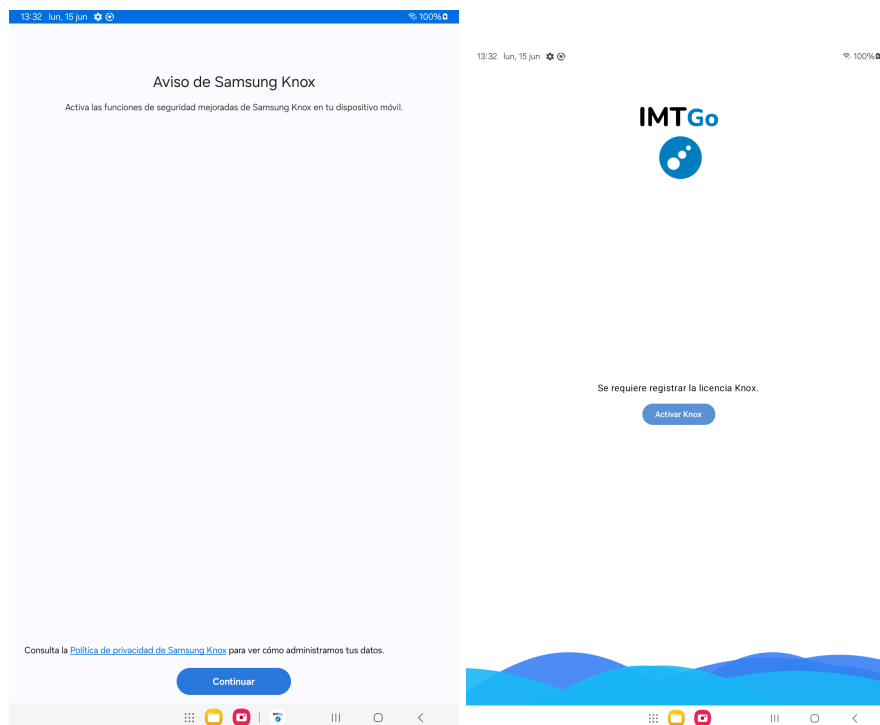
This is the core permission that enables remote device management. It ensures that the application cannot be uninstalled without authorization and allows IMTGo to perform secure management actions on the device.

Samsung KNOX Validation (Samsung Devices Only)

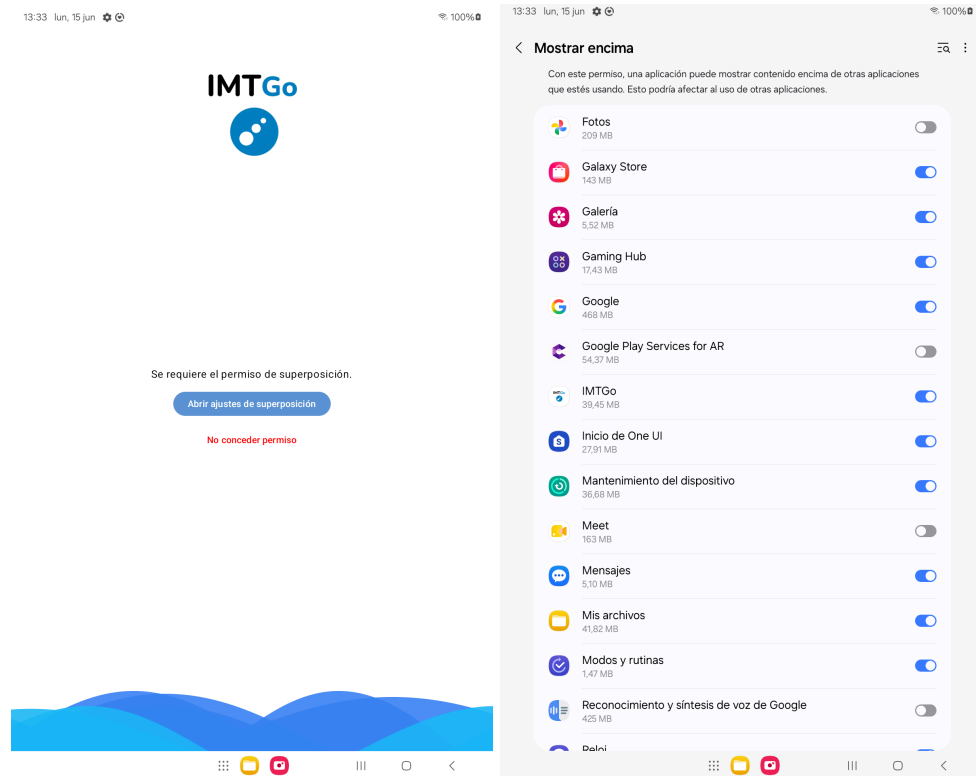
This step will only appear if you are configuring a Samsung device. It enables Samsung's advanced hardware-based security features, which are essential for classroom management and device control.

Display Over Other Apps Permission

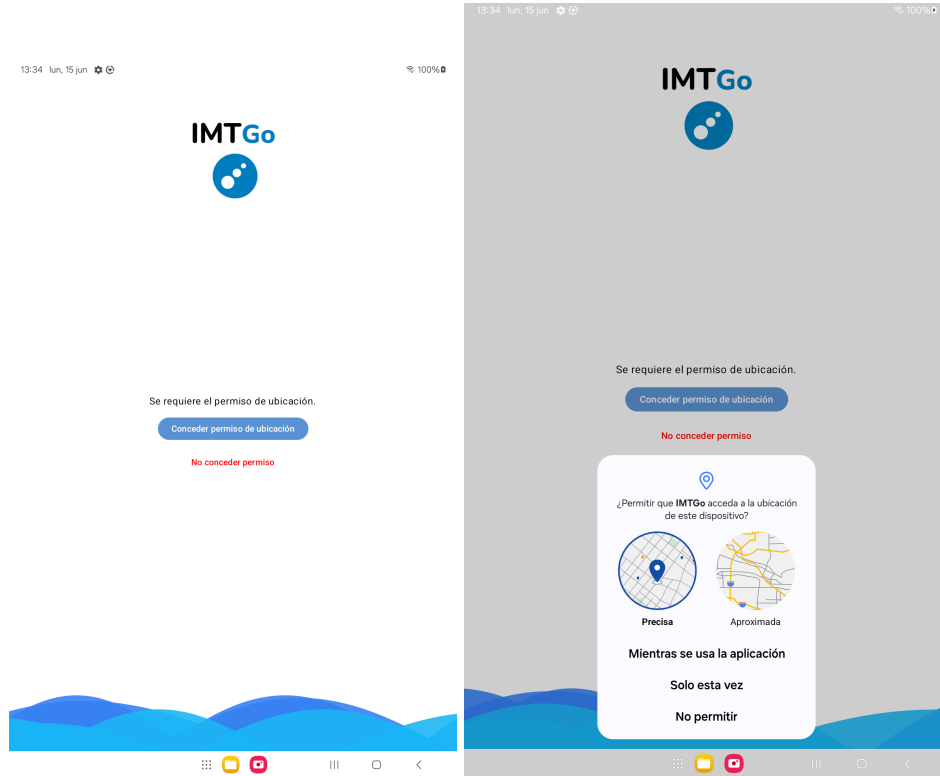
Although this permission is optional, it is highly recommended to enable it. It allows the application to display critical on-screen alerts and restrict device usage if a security violation is detected.

Device Location Permission

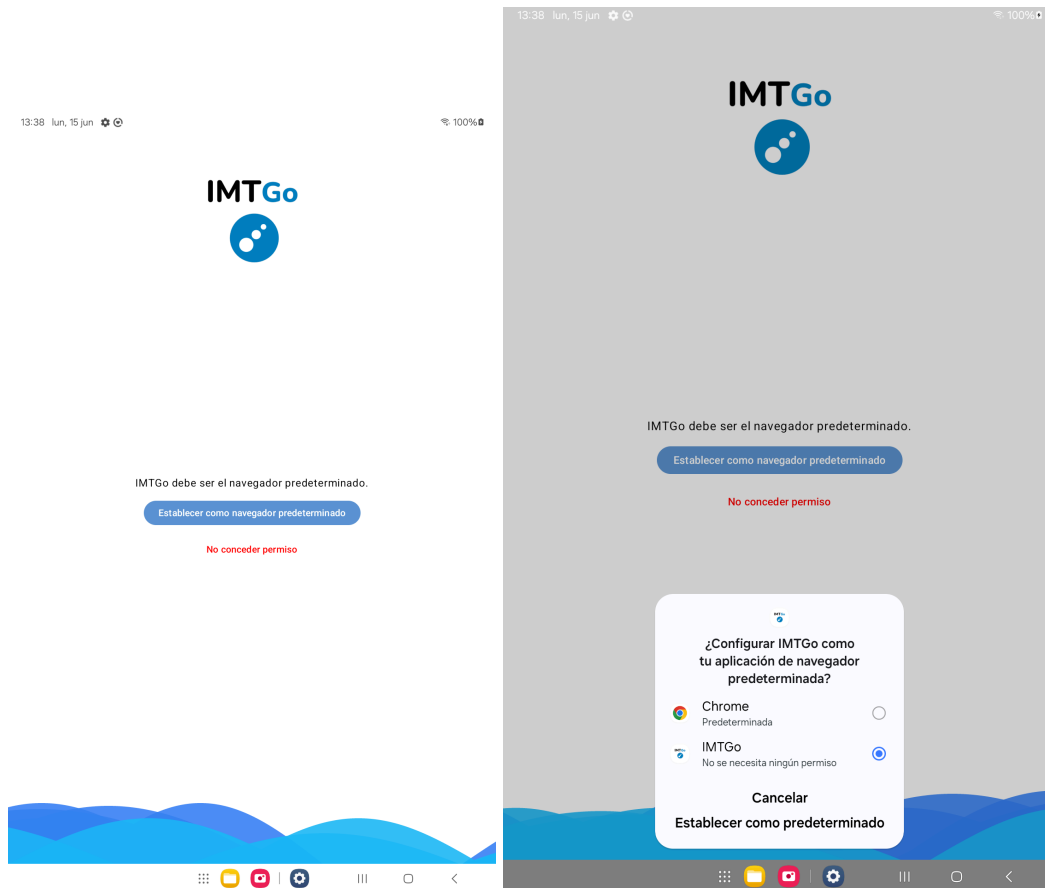
It is essential to enable this permission to allow device tracking and recovery in the event of loss or theft. It also enables the application of location-based policies and security features.



Installing IMTGo on Android

Set IMTGo as the Default Browser

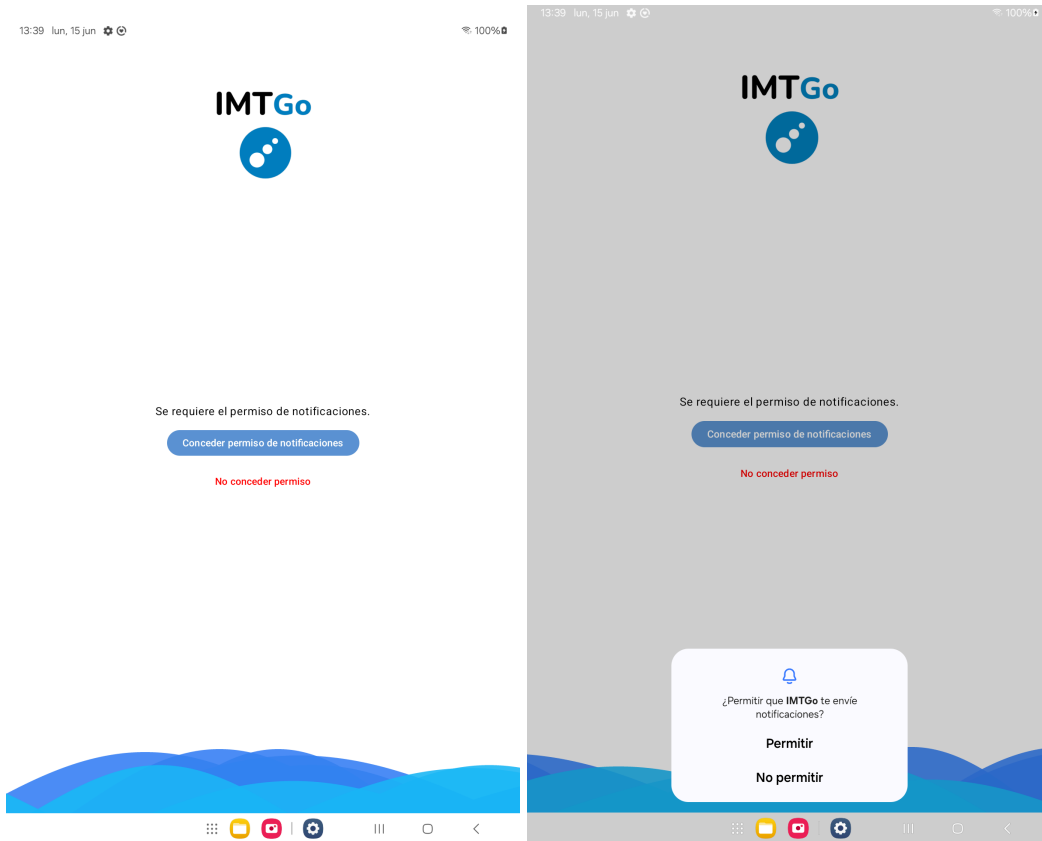
We strongly recommend enabling this setting. It allows IMTGo to filter web content in real time, helping protect users from malicious websites, inappropriate content, and other online security threats while ensuring a safer browsing experience.



Installing IMTGo on Android

Notification Permission

This permission is essential for receiving important device status updates, direct security alerts, and reminders related to policy compliance. Enabling notifications ensures that users and administrators are promptly informed of critical events and required actions.

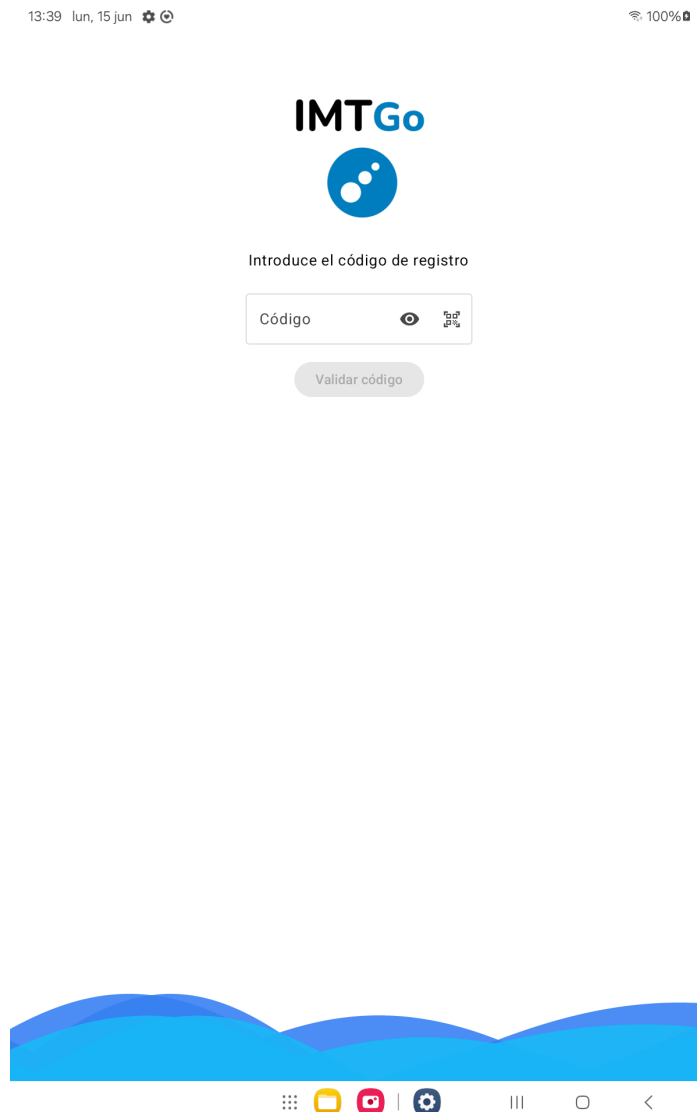


Installing IMTGo on Android

Enrollment

How to proceed: Enter the **enrollment code** provided by your administrator, or for greater convenience, use your device's camera to scan the **corresponding QR code**.

This step will register and identify the device on the IMTLazarus servers, allowing the appropriate policies, configurations, and security settings to be applied automatically.

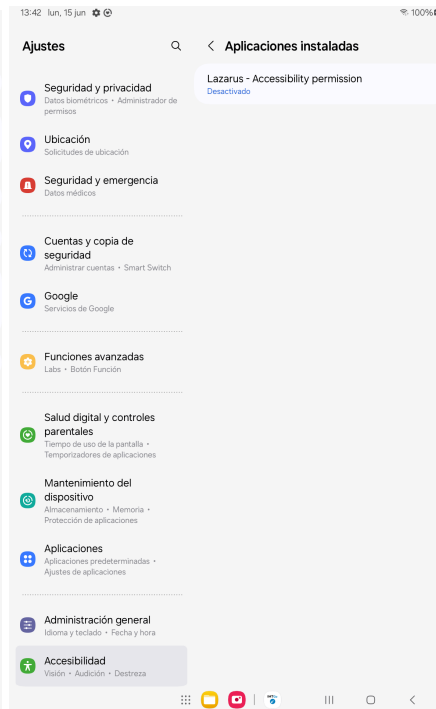
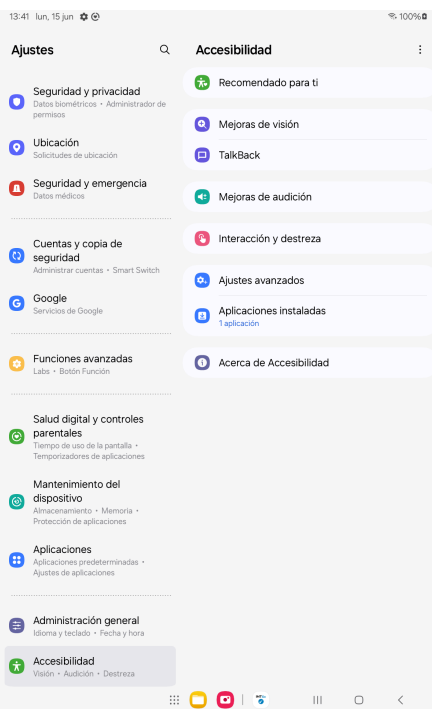
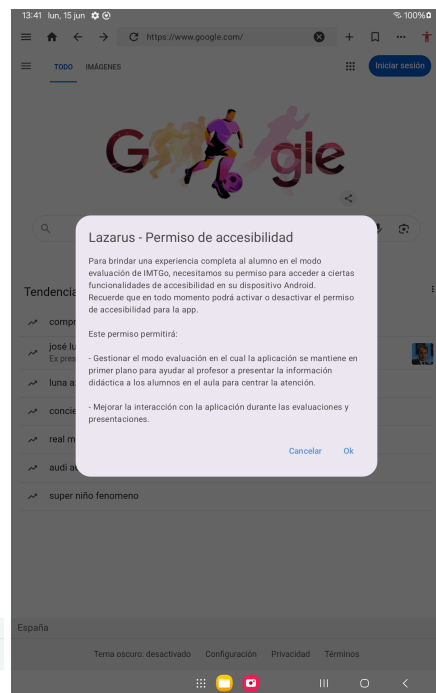
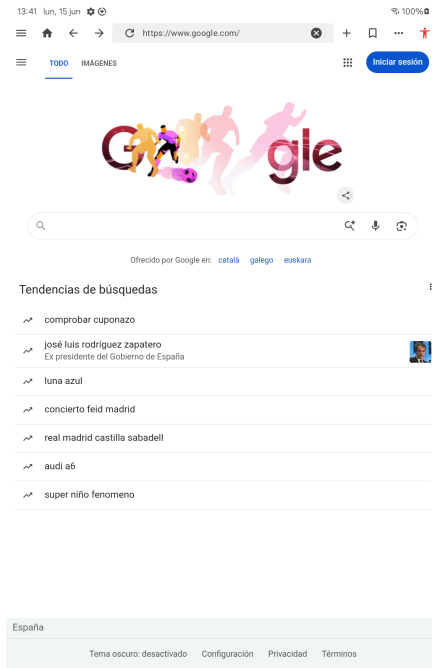
Accessibility Permission

This is the final step and, although it is optional, it is highly important. The Accessibility Service ensures that restrictions are applied correctly and helps prevent end users from bypassing the configured control policies.

To enable it, tap the red Accessibility icon and follow the on-screen steps to grant the required permission.

Once this permission has been enabled, the IMTGo installation and enrollment process will be complete, and the device will be fully managed according to the policies configured in IMTLazarus.
